Beginning at a pt. in the center of Clove creek and on the S. side of the Bridge on Newton Ave, where same crosses Clove creek and from said beginning running the following 3 courses down the middle of Clove creek. (1) S. $3^{\circ} 8'$ E. 113.23', (2) S. $18^{\circ} 28'$ W. 204.74'. (3) S. $4^{\circ} 58'$ W. 213.87' to a pt. in Clove creek 33' Northerly from the middle of the Loomis Ave. Bridge. (4) S. $84^{\circ} 13'$ W. 123.67' to an Iron pin which is 33' Northerly from the middle of Loomis Ave. (5) S. $77^{\circ} 30'$ W. 110.50' to an Iron pin which is 33' Northerly from the middle of Loomis Ave., at a pt. 20' W. from the W. side of a cattle pass under Loomis Ave. (6) N. $7^{\circ} 43'$ E. 164.86' to an Iron pin at a fence cor. post. (7) along a wire fence N. $22^{\circ} 47'$ W. 318.19' to a fence cor. post on the S. side of Newton Ave. (8) Along a stone Wall on the S. side of Newton Ave., N. $65^{\circ} 55'$ E. 95.74' to a stake. (9) still along said stone wall on the South side of Newton Ave. N. $79^{\circ} 17'$ E. 327.52' to the pt. of beginning. Cont. 3.39 acres.
