Being Lot #7, of nine lots laid out on the N W part of the farm of Anna J. De Witt. The whole plot of nine lots is bounded on the N W by lands of Amos Munson on the S W by the R R & on the S E by a St. known as Grove St., said St. enters the Main rd. fr. Deckertown (now Sussex) to Hamburg, entering the same W of the dwelling of the said Anna J. De Witt, & running N 50°, E fr. the main rd., to the line of lands of Lebeus Martin & on the N E by lands of said Lebeus Martin.

Lot No. 7 begins in the middle of Grove St., 150' fr. the 2nd cor. of Lot No. 4, & fr. thence, (1) N 40° W 175' to the lands of Amos Munson, (2) along said Munson's land N 44° 9' E, 50', (3) S 40° E 180' to the middle of the afore mentioned St., (4) S 50° W 50' to place of beg.
