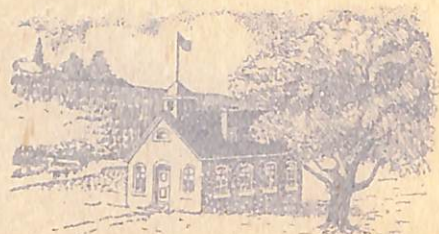

 Has earned a night's repose.



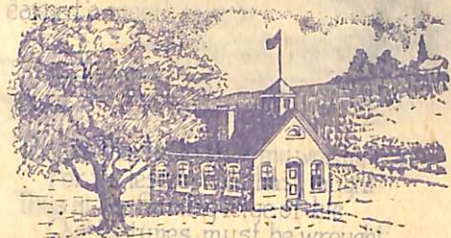
Thanks thanks to thee, my worthy friend,
