Beg. at a White Oak stump, said stump is the remains of a big tree, the 5th cor. of the 1st. tract of land conveyed by Geo. E. Dods to Emerson A. Hill, by deed Mar. 31, 1920, in Book X 11 pg. 52. Said beg. cor. is also the beg. cor. of the Lewis Hayne tract of 21.18 acres; & runs fr. thence: (1) S  $3^{\circ} 41'$  W 237.4' to a mark on a large rock; thence (2) S  $86^{\circ} 55'$  E 279' to stake & stones (3) N  $10^{\circ} 43'$  E 103.7' to stake & stones (4) N  $4^{\circ} 47'$  W 178.1' to stake & stones, (5) N  $56^{\circ} 58'$  E 227' to a cross cut on a rock (6) N  $60^{\circ} 26'$  E 388.3' to a pt. in the 3rd line of the tract of land 1st referred to above, thence by the 3rd line of said tract, (7) S  $76^{\circ} 25'$  W 536.7' to a stake thence by the 4th line of said tract, (8) S  $40^{\circ} 42'$  W 321.5' to a large rock near a brook; (9) N  $72^{\circ} 30'$  W 68' to the place of beg. Cont. 3 acres & 5 hundredths of an acre. Being a part of same lands & premises conveyed to the said Floyd Doty by J. Linn Quick & wife May 1, 1920, recorded in X 61 pg. 344.
