Porch porch

Beg. at a drill hole in a white flint rock at the junction of the center line of Liberty St. with the center line of Munson St. said pt. of beg. being $42 \frac{5}{10}$ ' fr. the nearest angle of Harrison House Porch, $37 \frac{3}{10}$ ' fr. the nearest cor. of the Ryerson store bldg. & 78' fr. the nearest cor. of the office bldg. on the herein conveyed property, & running thence: (1) N 35° W 250' to the center of E Main St., thence; (2) along the center of E Main St. N 55° E 365' to a pt. where the center line of Cross St. intersects the center line of E Main St., thence, (3) S $33 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 200' to a pt. between the rails of a switch tract, $16 \frac{4}{10}$ ' fr. the nearest cor. of the grist mill & 49' fr. the N E angle of the S. R. R. freight house, thence, (4) along the line of the R.R. property following a curve of about 5° , the bearing of the cord being S 36° W 164' to the center line of Munson St., thence along the center line of Munson St. S 55° W 206' to the place of beg.
